National Grid Electricity Transmission (NGET) is consulting on proposals to build approximately 60 kilometres of new overhead electricity line between Chesterfield and Willington.

Our existing power lines do not have the sufficient capacity for all the new sources of energy, mostly from offshore wind, due to connect to the network over the next ten years and beyond. Our Chesterfield to Willington proposals would allow clean energy to be connected to the network and carried to the homes and businesses that need it.

Our proposals are part of The Great Grid Upgrade - the largest overhaul of the grid in generations.

During this consultation, we are seeking views and local knowledge about the proposed area within which the pylons could be routed.

Your feedback will play an important role in helping us to develop and refine our proposals. The deadline to provide feedback is **11:59pm on Tuesday 9 July 2024.**
