#### Police Items 240/14

In the absence of a police representative the month's crime and anti-social behaviour statistics were presented by the clerk who also informed the Council of his meetings with the local police relating to a number of incidents on the Mickley estate. The application for a Public Space Protection Order was also discussed. Cllr Jones informed council that possible funding for CCTV has been identified. AGREED: The Clerk obtained quotes to identify costs of fixing the separate camera.

#### **Public Participation 241/14**

Members of the public raised concerns relating to traffic congestion on the A61 at Clay Cross and approaching Alfreton from Shirland. The road works in Higham were also causing problems. Cllr Brown complained that the County Council was not informing Council of planned road works. AGREED: The Clerk writes to County Councillor Lewis about these matters. (Session timed at 10 minutes)

#### **Continuing Items**

Shirland Village Hall 242/14, (210/14, 180/14)

Quotes have been received for the roof work. The architect and builder will be meeting to discuss a possible schedule of work on the 26<sup>th</sup> January 2015. Cllr Barns and the Clerk will be meeting the Village Hall Committee to discuss the payment of utility bills.

Shirland Cemetery 243/14 No interments. New pricing structure is now in operation.

Dog Bins 244/14

RESOLVED: A new dog bin will be installed at the top of Hallfieldgate Lane at its junction with the A61.

#### Mickley Bike Track 245/14

The Clerk informed the meeting that despite repeated phone calls to the main contractor, no signage had been erected. He has been assured the signs will be in place by the end of January.

Vandalism 246/14

The broken glass in the northbound bus shelter on the A61 has been repaired again. RESOLVED: A suitable toughened glass replacement will be sourced for any further breakages.

Stonebroom School Wall 247/14

RESOLVED: Cllr Bacon informed Council that the repairs to the wall have been carried out to a high standard.

Cllr Williamson proposed that Council approach BT for permission to adopt the phone box with a view to changing the use to a book exchange. AGREED: The Clerk will commence the adoption process with BT and consult with North East Derbyshire District Council.

#### Seating at 'Red Arrow' Bus Shelters, Higham 254/14

A parishioner has requested Council provide seating at the bus stops. AGREED: The parishioner can be supplied with a modified walking stick that can fold into a seat to make his/her wait more comfortable. A Councillor will donate the walking stick.
