SHIRLAND AND HIGHAM PARISH COUNCIL Minutes of the meeting held in Shirland Village Hall Monday 18th July 2016, 19:00

Councillors Present: Mr B Barnes, Mr D Williamson, Mrs A Brown, Mrs Sue Smith, Mr P Allsop, Mr A Wild, Mr S Davis.

In Attendance: Tom Tait (Assistant Clerk), Sally Plummer (Clerk/RFO), District Cllr Cupid and 6 members of the public.

1/7/16 Cllr Brown proposed the minutes to be accepted as a true record and Cllr Davis seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved.

2/7/16 Apologies were received from County Councillor Barry Lewis

3/7/16 No declarations of interest were recorded

4/7/16 No Pecuniary Interests were disclosed

5/7/16 Co-option: Mrs Julia Williamson asked to be considered for co-option to the Parish Council. This was unanimously approved and Mrs Williamson will be co-opted at the October 2016 meeting when residency criteria has been met.

6/7/16 No items will be held with the public excluded.

7/7/16 Police Issues: Due to no Police presence the Clerk read out the local crime statistics which were recorded as seven crimes and seven incidents of anti-social behaviour. The assistant Clerk informed the meeting that he will shortly be accompanying the Safer Neighbourhood Team on a shift to gain greater insight into their valuable work.

8/7/16 Public Participation: Three members of the public asked to address the meeting in relation to a financial contribution to help pay for the installation of a defibrillator to be sited at the Miners Welfare, Shirland. Two of the three members of the public were Tibshelf First Responders and were supportive of the proposal. Following a number of questions asked by Council, Cllr Williamson proposed that the Parish Council would donate the full cost of the purchase and installation of the defibrillator. This was seconded by Cllr Davis and unanimously approved by Council.

9/7/16 Public Notice Boards: Cllr Barnes raised the issue of a noticeboard for Stonebroom now that the previous board has been removed. It was agreed that a new site for a noticeboard in Stonebroom be sought.

10/7/16 Stonebroom Pavilion: The guttering at Stonebroom Pavilion has been extensively damaged and needs replacing. The Clerk is currently seeking quotes relating to the installation of anti-vandal guttering.

11/7/16 Shirland Village Hall: A new pump has been purchased for Shirland Village Hall. During the removal of the failed pump it was noted that routine maintenance required periodic removal of the pump for lubrication and cleaning. A new schedule is being compiled by the installing contractor to ensure the appropriate level of maintenance is carried out on the new pump.

12/7/16 Continuing Items

a Play Areas: Repairs have been completed. The Clerk is currently seeking quotes for the maintenance of the play equipment. It was agreed that the Stonebroom equipment will be painted this year.

b HRH Birthday Commemoration: The commemorative bench has now been delivered and will be installed in the next week.

c Shirland Cemetery: There has been some further subsidence in the older part of the cemetery. Top soil will be purchased and the gardener will make good any leaning headstones. It was noted how nice the Cemetery is looking and this will be fed back to the relevant employees and contractors.

d Shirland Village Hall lease: The sub group looking into the re-leasing of the hall is awaiting data from the Village Hall Management Committee to enable it to complete a discussion document to be circulated to Councillors.

e Mining Memorial: The Assistant Clerk reported he was having difficulty sourcing copyright free photographs for the display board but is continuing his efforts.

13/7/16 No report was available from the County Councillor

14/7/16 Cllr Cupitt gave an overview of matters relating to devolved government and the possibility of Chesterfield district joining Sheffield District

15/7/16 Reports from Councillors on Outside Bodies: Cllr Brown intimated that Cllr Barnes and her meeting with the Mickley carnival group had been cancelled at short notice. Councillors expressed concerns relating to event insurance and the need to clarify a number of issues.
